

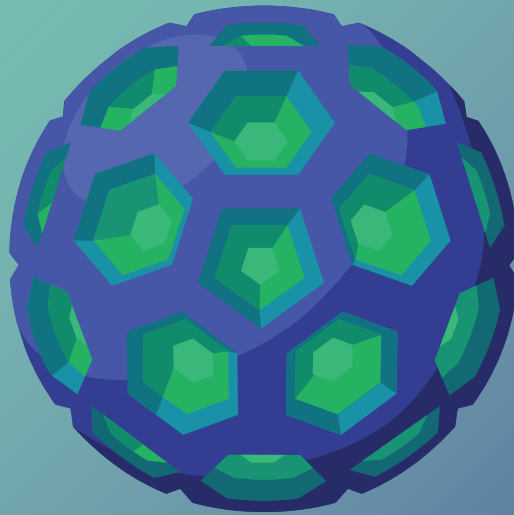
# NoroCORE

NoroCORE began in 2011 with the goal of reducing the burden of foodborne illness caused by viruses. It was one of two \$25M USDA-NIFA CAP grants, the largest of their kind, and signified a new, multidisciplinary approach to solving a complex problem. It began with 18 collaborative institutions representing academia and government.



Seven years later, our Collaborative has expanded to include eight additional institutions, over 30 investigators, and more than 100 stakeholder organizations.
